Our Pastor Fr. Alberto J. Borruel has made updates to our Mass times beginning this weekend. You may view a video of the announcement on our website www.nsgduadalupe.org or on our Facebook page Our Lady Guadalupe. The following is a summary of the video. You are asked to watch the video for the full message.

We will return to the Mass times before the pandemic began with the exception of a few things.

- Every Mass is open to the public; however, the capacity inside the church remains at 40, excluding those helping with Mass.
- Saturday Vigil Mass - 5:00PM - English, will not be video streamed
- Sunday Mass - 8:00AM - Spanish - video streamed
- Sunday Mass - 10:30AM - English - video streamed
- Sunday Mass - 1:00PM - Spanish - will not be video streamed
- The Saturday 7pm and Sunday 5pm Mass will be cancelled going forward.
- Daily Mass - 8:00AM - Tuesday - Friday - video streamed and open to public
- Holy Hour will continue on Thursday at 7pm - live video streamed and is open to the public with a limited capacity.
- The church will be open from 9:00AM - 6:00PM Monday - Friday for those who would like to visit.
- After your visits to the church, Fr. Alberto has asked that you clean your spot where you sat with wipes, or disinfectant spray that will be provided in the church.
- Physical distancing guidelines are still to be followed - 6ft apart in all directions
- Any person entering the church is required to wear a mask or other type of face covering. Gloves are suggested to be worn, if possible.
- When receiving Communion, you are asked to receive in the hand without gloves. Please be sure to remove gloves before receiving in the hand.
- Confessions will be on Saturday 9AM - 10AM or by appointment.
- Anointing of the Sick - If a person is in need of this sacrament, contact the office to schedule a visit.
- Baptisms - Contact the Parish office for more information and guidelines
- Weddings - Fr. Alberto will contact those who have been preparing on how to proceed. Contact the parish office for more information.
- Fr. Alberto asks that we all do our part in taking the necessary precautions with this COVID-19 pandemic.
- **Office Hours:** Please be aware that the office is closed to the public at this time. Staff has returned to working in the office and is able to respond to your messages and emails.
