**Catechism Class Selections:**

There are different paths that a child may be on for sacramental preparation depending on the age of the child and if they have ever received catechism classes before. Please make your selection to the best of your ability. If you are transferring to OLG from another Parish, welcome. We will need a letter of enrollment from your prior parish.

**\*\*Documentation needed for any child enrolling - copies of: Birth Certificate, Baptism Certificate, if applicable, and any other Sacramental Certificate that they have received. Please confirm with the REd office that they have a copy on file if you were enrolled the 2020 - 2021 year. If you were not enrolled in 2020-2021 then you will need to provide this documentation.**

**Brief Definition of Catechism Class Selections:**

Here at OLG we encourage 3 years of formation for sacramental preparation. There are exceptions; however. It all depends on how prepared the child is and when they are ready. All children receiving a Sacrament must visit with the Pastor who will determine readiness.

Traditional Path - Children who have been Baptized and began catechism classes in the First Grade and were younger than 7 years old, when they began.

High School Youth Ministry - HSYM - All high school students enrolled will be in HSYM. Those needing sacraments will attend a separate sacramental preparation class on a different day.

Continuing Education - Children who are on the Traditional Path or have received their Sacraments and are continuing their faith formation and are not in sacramental preparation.

Baptized & Un-Catechized - Children who have been Baptized and began catechism classes at 2nd grade or later and were 7 years old or older when they began. These children will be formed for a minimum of 3 years and upon readiness will receive the sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation at a Confirmation Mass, in the 3rd year of formation or when they are ready.

RCIA Path - Children who have NOT been Baptized and are older than 7 years old and are preparing to receive all their Sacraments - Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation. These children will be formed for a minimum of 3 years and upon readiness will receive all 3 sacraments at the Easter Vigil of their 3rd year of formation or when they are ready.

For your information, students who may be wanting a Quincenera(o) must be enrolled in Catechism for at least the 2 years prior to the date of the event.

- High School Youth Ministry - High School Grades 9 - 12 (All high school students will be in HSYM. Those preparing for sacraments will have a separate class to attend for formation)
- Baptized & Un-Catechized Year I (children who began sacramental preparation at age 7 or older and this is their 1st year of Catechism Classes)
- Baptized & Un-Catechized Year II (children who began sacramental preparation at age 7 or older and have attended 1 year of catechism classes)
- Baptized & Un-Catechized Year III (children who began sacramental preparation at age 7 or older and have attended 2 years of catechism classes)
- RCIA Year I (children who have NOT been baptized and are 7 years old and older and have never attended catechism classes previously)
- RCIA Year II (children who have NOT been baptized and are 7 years old and older and have attended 1 year of catechism classes previously)
- RCIA Year III (children who have NOT been baptized and are 7 years old and older and have attended 2 years of catechism classes previously)

**Sacramental Preparation Classes**

First Communion Classes will occur within the same time of usual REd classes. There may be exceptions; however, depending on the path your child is on.

Confirmation Classes will occur on Sunday afternoons at 3pm once they begin. They will be a separate class from High School Youth Ministry.

Baptized & Un-Catechized and RCIA paths may require additional classes, but will be discussed on a case by case situation.

**Class times and days for regular REd courses**

Grades 1 - 4 will meet on Monday's at 6:30pm - 7:30pm - English & Spanish Classes available

Grades 5 - 8 will meet on Tuesday's at 7:00pm - 8:15pm - English & Spanish Classes available for 5th & 6th grade. 7th & 8th grade classes will be in English with a bilingual Catechist.

Grades 9 - 12 will meet on Wednesday's at 7:00pm - 8:30pm English classes with bilingual Youth Minister

All 3rd year RCIA children regardless of grade will meet on Tuesday's at 7:00pm due to the fact that their formation is a bit different. Language will depend on enrollment and preferred language.

IF space and class size warrants it, we may open up a Sunday class, but that will be determined on enrollment numbers and Catechist availability.
